NOTICE TO PARENT / GUARDIAN:

This letter is to inform you that your child has registered for a Student Card with the Grand County Public Library.

A Student Card is free. With this card, your child may:

- Check out two items at a time**
- Use library computers, free**
- Access online homework help and resources**

Items checked out on this card do not accrue fines or fees. If an item is overdue for over 28 days the card will not allow further check outs until the item is returned.

R-rated DVDs and CDs with explicit song lyrics may not be checked out.

Your child is allowed to have one Grand County Library card at a time. If at any time you would like to upgrade the Student Card to a regular use Juvenile or Teen Card please stop by the library with your ID and proof of address. By changing the status of a Student Card to a Juvenile or Teen Card, you are assuming responsibility for any items checked out on the card.
